

We are excited to provide you with our annual report for the 2010 year. The Cancer Foundation of Northeast Georgia set two very important goals for 2010. The first goal was to provide \$50,000 in financial assistance to cancer patients in need and the second goal was to host the inaugural "Tri to Beat Cancer - Sprint Triathlon". We are pleased to report that we achieved both of these goals. The Tri to Beat Cancer-Sprint Triathlon raised over \$75,000 and sold out 4 weeks early. The Athens community embraced this event with over 100 volunteers and a large spectator crowd at the event. Additionally, we saw an increase in our individual donors as well as community groups such as Athens Area Cancer Auxiliary and the North Georgia Jaycees. 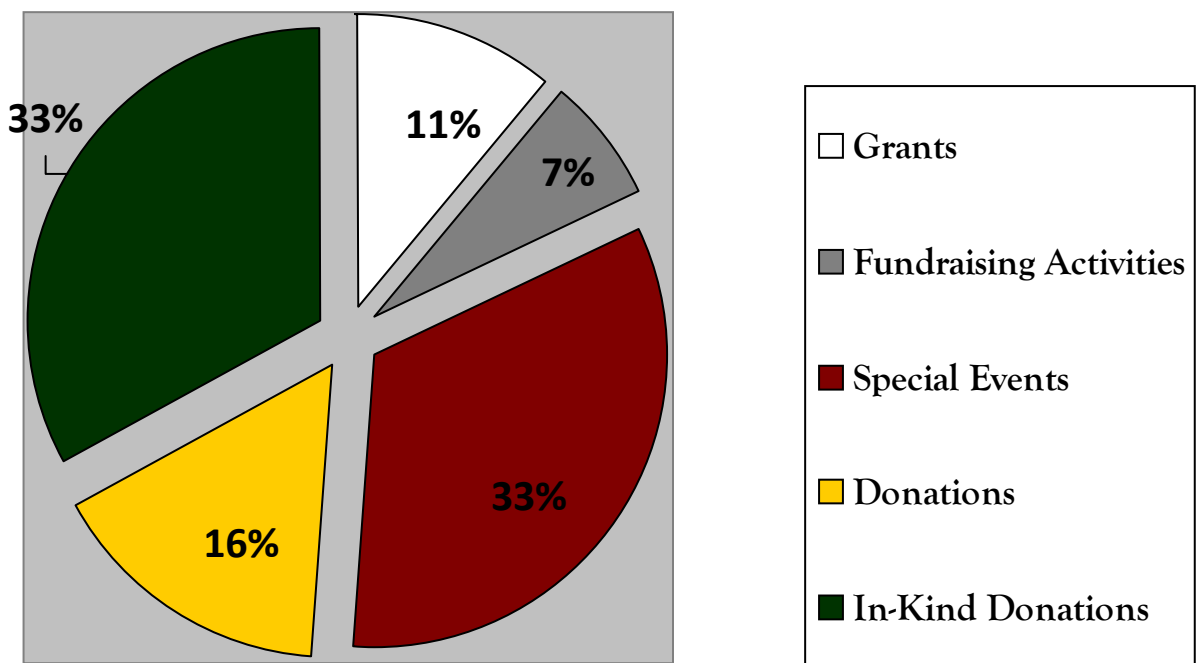

Funding Breakdown

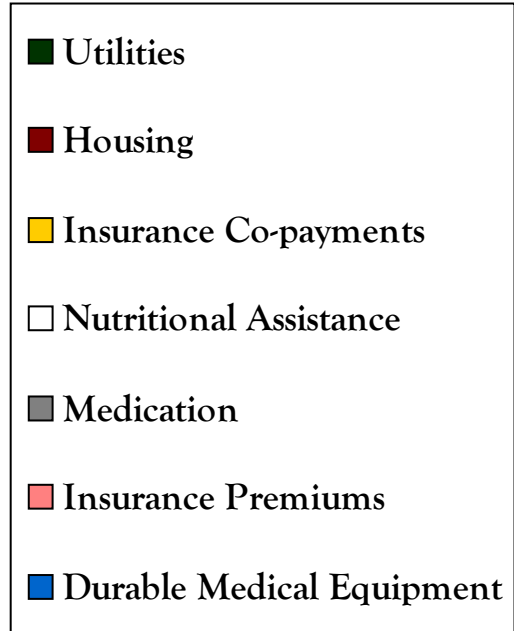
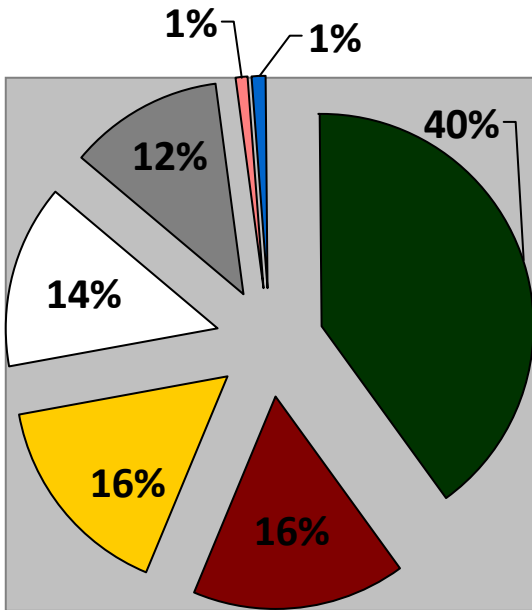

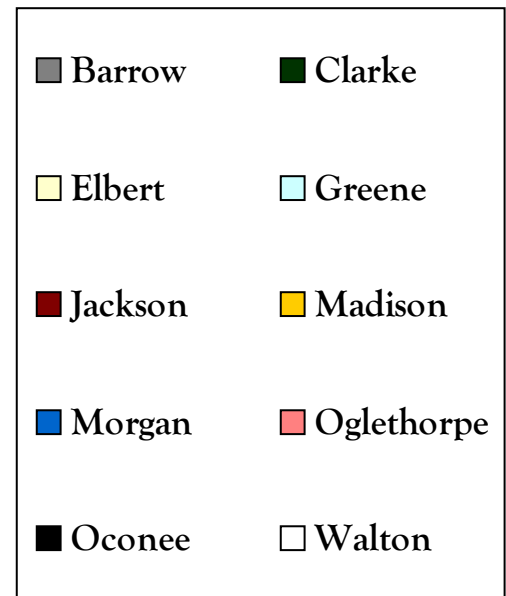
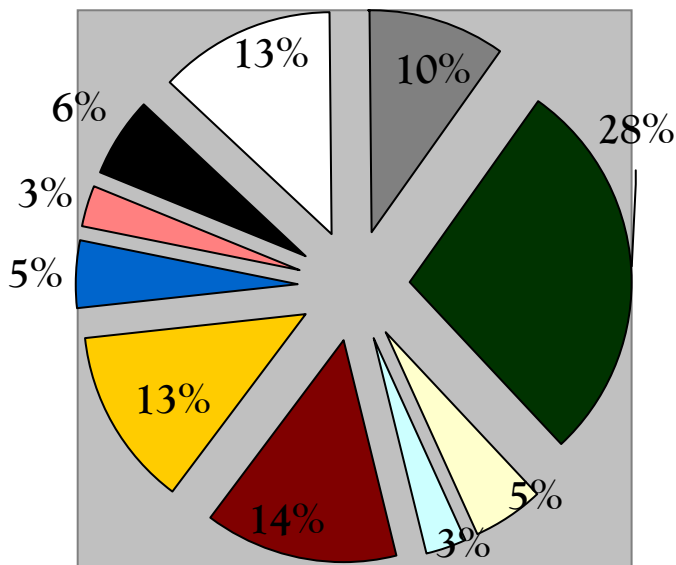
Financial Assistance Program-
