Financial Assistance Program

The Financial assistance Program (FAP) was established in 2008 to provide emergency monetary assistance to cancer patients who are in financial crisis due to a cancer diagnosis. The FAP is the CFNEGA'S only program, helping cancer patients with basic life needs such as a rent, mortgage, utilities, nutrition, medication, durable medical equipment, insurance premiums, and insurance co-payments. The CFNEGA pays the creditor owed, with the goal of providing assistance within 24 hours.

We proudly serve Banks, Barrow, Clarke, Elbert, Franklin, Greene, Hart, Jackson, Madison, Morgan, Oconee, Oglethorpe, Putnam, Stephens and Walton counties.
